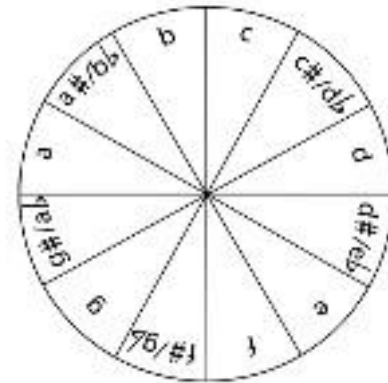
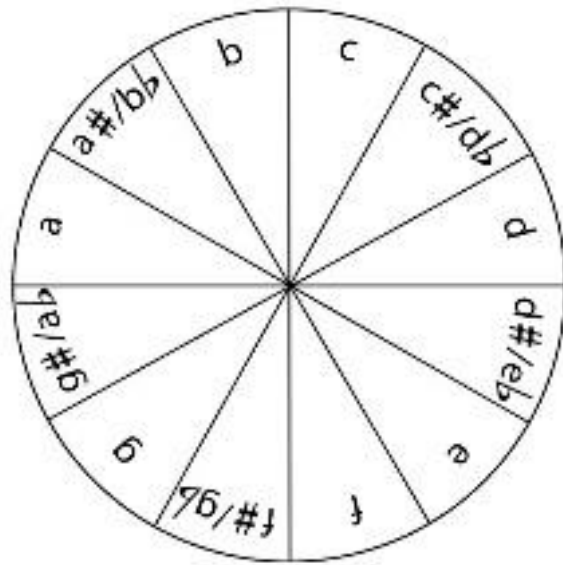


Transpose with the transpose disc

You need the big disc and the small disc from the PDF file and a split pin

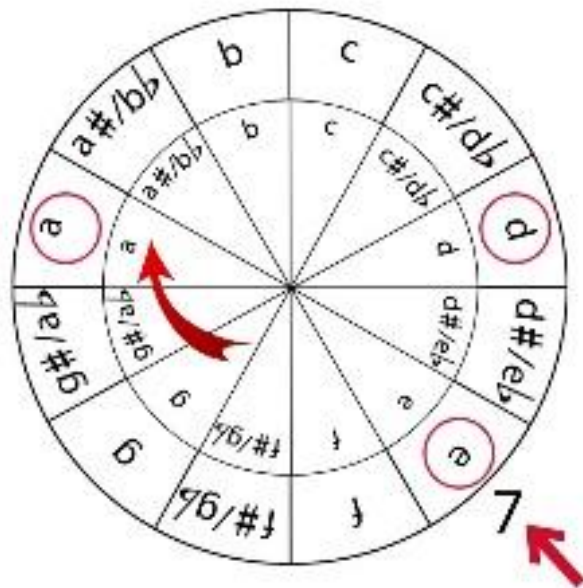


Cut the discs out of sturdy cardboard and secure them together with the split pin

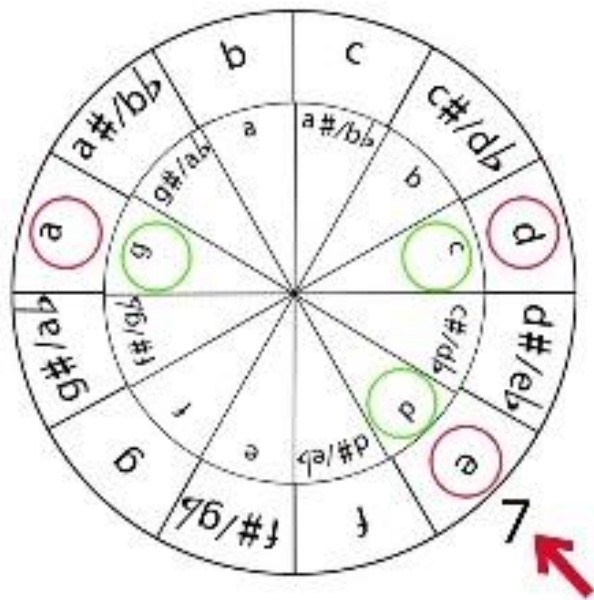
You want to make a song lower



Suppose you have a song in A,
for example A, D and E7

Turn the inner ring from G to A

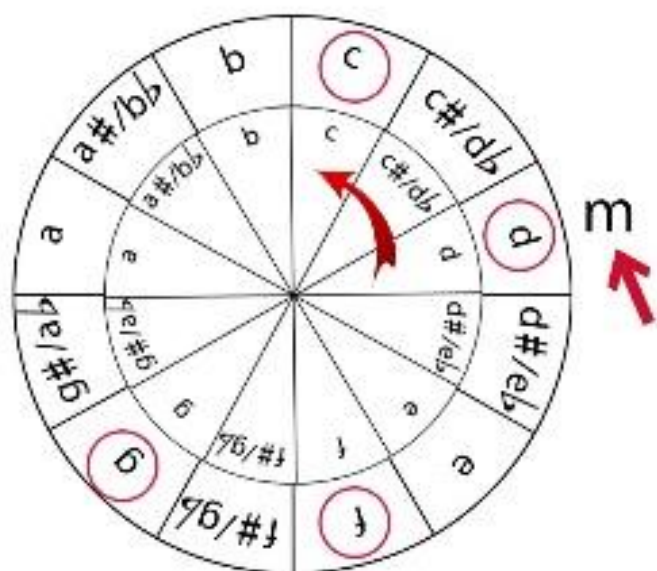
Now you can read the new chords,
don't forget the addition,
in this case 7



You can see that the G is now under the A, the C under the D and the D under the E

So your new chord combination is: G, C and D7

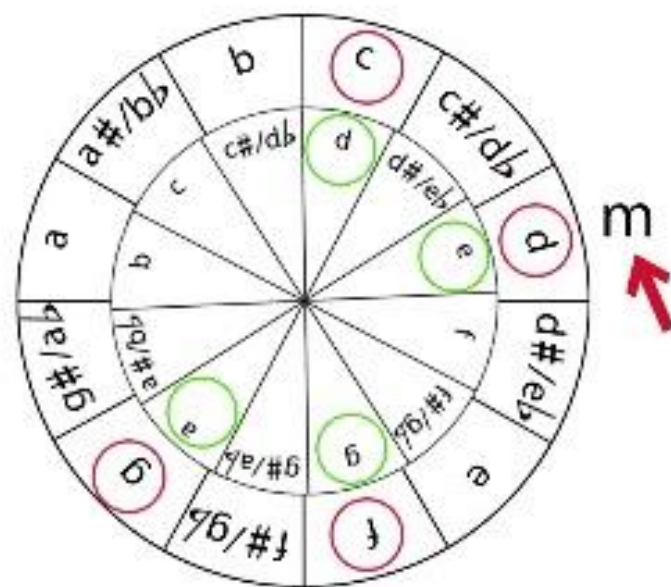
You want to make a song higher



Suppose you have a song in C,
for example C Dm F and G

You turn the inner ring
from D to C.

You can now read the new chords,
don't forget the addition,
in this case m



You can see that the D is now under the C, the E under the D, the G under the F and the A under the G

So your new chord combination is: D, Em, G and A

You can of course also use a capo if you make a song higher
